

**ORDINANCE NO.9.14**  
**CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH**  
**AN ORDINANCE OPTING-OUT OF**  
**THE REQUIREMENTS OF**  
**MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593**

**WHEREAS**, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

**WHEREAS**, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to “opt out” of those regulations;

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANHATTAN BEACH, ORDAINS as follows:**

**Section 9.14 Manhattan Beach Zoning Ordinance, Section 9 is amended as follows:**

**OPT-OUT OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593:**

**SECTION 9.14.01** Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of Manhattan Beach opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.

**SECTION 9.14.02.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.

**ADOPTED** this 30 day of AUGUST, 2016, by the City Council of the City of Manhattan Beach.
